

## **7<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys Secular Studies Supply List 2019 – 2020**

*Note that multi-purpose supplies may be used for multiple subjects. Please maintain proper working supplies throughout the school year. A good pencil case to keep supplies organized and together is recommended.*

*Also note that there may be a few additional small supplies needed over the course of the school year. Requests for any additional materials will be made with reasonable time for acquiring these materials.*

### **General Supplies- to be shared and used for all classes**

- 1 USB thumb drive to use for saving documents for classes other than computer class
- 1 1-inch binder (to be used for homework binder)
- 1 2-pocket folders with holes to fit inside binder
- 1 package loose-leaf paper

### **Math**

- 1 1½-inch binder (labeled MATH, with your name on it)
- 2 packages graph ruled filler paper (either 4 or 5 squares per inch)
- 1 package loose-leaf dividers with tabs
- 1 package of reinforcements
- 1 large book cover (book sock) for the textbook
- 1 calculator (similar to Texas Instruments TI-30Xa Scientific Calculator)
- 1 12-inch ruler labeled with inches and centimeters
- 1 pencil case
- eraser
- 1 box pencils (if mechanical pencils also have extra lead; if wood pencils also have a sharpener)
- scissors
- 1 3-hole punch that clips inside the binder
- 1 box of tissues

### **Science**

- 1 1½-inch binders (labeled SCIENCE, with your name on it)
- 2 packages loose-leaf paper
- 1 package loose-leaf dividers with tabs
- eraser
- pencils (if mechanical pencils also have extra lead; if wood pencils also have a sharpener)
- art supplies: i.e. scissors, scotch tape, glue stick, markers or colored pencils
- 1 large book cover (book sock) for the textbook
- 1 sturdy 2-pocket folder

**Social Studies & Language Arts**

- 2 1½-inch binder (one for SS and one for LA)
- 2 packs of lined, 3-hole punched paper
- 2 sets of dividers (5 tabs each)
- 4 folders
- 10 black or blue pens
- 4 highlighters
- markers
- colored pencils
- scissors

Later in the year, students may be asked to bring 2 tri-folds, 3 foot high display board (needed for Science Fair and Math 'n Torah Fair in the spring, opens to 36in x 48in)
